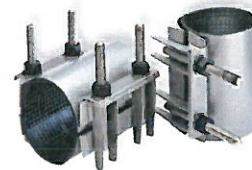

Hour One

We will discuss Hydrant Security Devices which prevent tampering with hydrants and their applications. We will also cover the safe operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of fire hydrants.

Hour Two

We will discuss gate valves, focusing on how they operate and the importance of the preventative maintenance of each to ensure proper working condition.
